



Yarn Sewing
INSTRUCTIONS



Getting Started

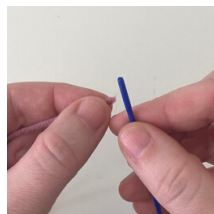
MATERIALS

You'll need yarn, scissors, and a blunt tipped needle like the blue plastic needle. Extra yarn is great to have on hand!



THREADING THE NEEDLE

Pinch the end of the yarn and hold that hand still. Bring the eye of the needle to the yarn and wiggle it until the fibers poke through.



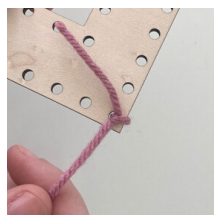
SECURE THE YARN

Tie the yarn to the end of the needle for beginning sewers, or pinch the yarn at the end of the needle as you sew.



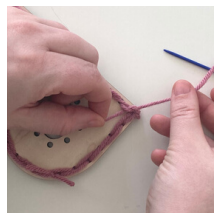
FIRST STITCH

Starting from the back side of the board, bring your needle through the first hole and tie the end of the yarn to the board.



ENDING

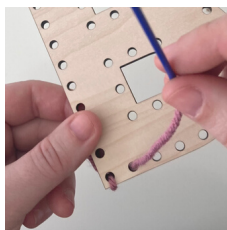
After your last stitch, tie the yarn to another hanging piece on the back, or take your needle under the previous stitch to create a loop. Pull your thread through the loop to make a knot.

STITCH GUIDE

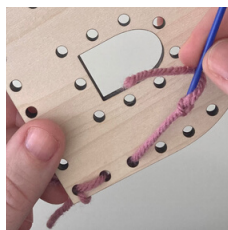
BACK STITCH "UP THROUGH THE OPEN HOLE, DOWN THROUGH THE LAST"



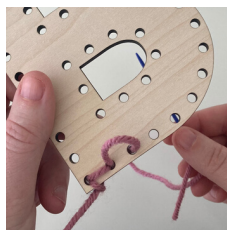
After tying the yarn to the board, bring your needle up through the second hole in the line



Take your needle back down through the first hole

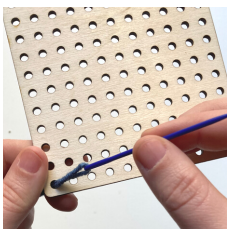


Repeat this process by coming up through the next hole

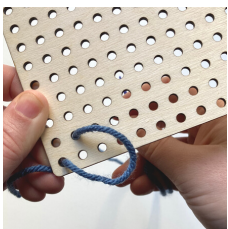


And going back down through the previous hole

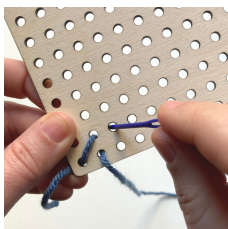
CROSS STITCH "UP THROUGH THE BOTTOM HOLE, ACROSS AND DOWN"



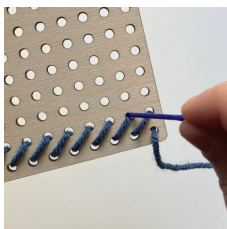
Working left to right, come up through the first hole



Go down through the diagonal hole



Repeat- up through the bottom hole, down through the diagonal hole



At the end of your row, do the same steps in reverse

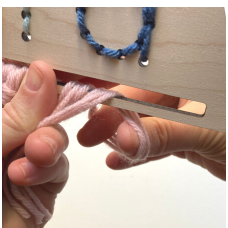
FRINGE KNOTS



Cut three equal pieces of yarn and fold them in half



Pinch the loop at the top and push it through the opening



Put your other fingers through the loop and grab the rest of the yarn



Pull the yarn through the loop and pull tight. Trim yarn once all knots are finished
